This dress code has been developed to assure that no one will feel offended or uncomfortable during his or her participation and that we honor God in everything we do. If you choose to dress inappropriately, you will be asked to change, or be required to wear a Campus Life issued shirt. By planning ahead and choosing appropriately, you will save yourself the inconvenience of having to change and you will be contributing to a pleasant atmosphere. Please be advised that the following dress code will be enforced for all individuals including staff and counselors.

Clothing:

1. Clothing that displays inappropriate/bad words, products, or slogans are not allowed
2. Excessively baggy or tight clothing (leggings + biker shorts) are not allowed
3. Clothing that shows (or are transparent) belly buttons, bare chests, bare back, or underwear are not allowed
4. Tank tops must have a strap width of at least one inch. Spaghetti straps, camisoles, tube tops, and halter tops are not allowed
5. Shorts must have a minimum of a 4 inch inseam
6. Please do not wear T-shirts with sleeves cut off.
